



Cooperating partner

WHO

People and organisations who have signed the Charter, who contribute to the work of CES and are actively involved in the circular economy movement. Their contribution can be financial or in-kind. If you are interested in getting involved as a Partner, you can apply to the Executive Committee, outlining your contribution to the work of CES. The Executive Committee decides whether to admit new partners.

WHAT

As a Cooperating Partner, you can participate in the annual CES General Assembly, and help decide and shape the movement's priorities. Additionally, you can use the logo and claim of Circular Economy Switzerland in your own communications. You automatically become a CES member, you get a vote, and help elect the Executive Committee.

What's in it for you

All the advantages enjoyed by CES Charter signatories, plus:

- You get to shape CES strategy
- You get to be more prominently featured in CES communications
- You become a CES member (with voting rights)
- You become eligible for the Executive Committee

Get involved in the

Executive Committee

WHO

The Executive Committee is made up of five to eight Partners, who have signed the Charter and have each been elected by the General Assembly for a two-year mandate.

WHAT

Members of the Executive Committee have access to a broad network and can use the CES logo and claim by incorporating it in their own communications. The Executive Committee has the power to actively shape CES, as it develops, co-ordinates and implements CES strategy. It decides on the admission of potential new partners, elects the coordinating body and, together with it, represents CES.

What's in it for you

All the advantages of the CES Partners, plus:

- · Direct access to our broad network
- The opportunity to shape CES strategy
- Regular dialogue and closer cooperation

What you have to do

- Sign the CES Charter
- Become a CES Partner
- Steer CES strategy through regular exchange with the Executive Committee
